We usually use **Monkey's Cheat Sheet** to summarize the printing (**example on website**) but this is a mystery, so the Cheat Sheet is a little bit different. The evidence is revealed a bit at a time.

The diagrams show how to position the FP on the fabric to make the best use of yardage and there are notes for printing on scraps. Please see the video for alternatives to printing every shape.






